St. Francis Food Pantries and Shelters realizes the stresses that many New Yorker's face due to the lingering effects of the pandemic, inflation, and disruptions in the supply chain. We realize that these obstacles cause a domino effect that hinders businesses, individuals, and families. In partnership with the agencies we serve, our goal is to lessen the effects of poverty through the provision of food, clothing, daily living essentials, and financial support.

Some of the issues our partner agencies faced were low financial resources necessary to serve the influx of migrants, residents affected by decreased wages and the homeless. Although, this is the reality we face St. Francis Food Pantries and Shelters remains devoted to our commitment to serving the less fortunate. We accomplished this through our fundraising efforts and partnerships with donors.

In 2022, we served over 300,000 families by distributing over 3,000 thousand cases of food to our community pantries, soup kitchens, and drop-in centers. The provision of grants has also allowed us to support our partnering agencies that services those affected by mental health, and social issues.

We have also been fortunate to partner with other corporations who provided in-kind contributions and corporate volunteers who devoted their time to support St. Francis Food Pantries and Shelters' mission. That work supported individuals through social engagement for seniors, children, and families.
